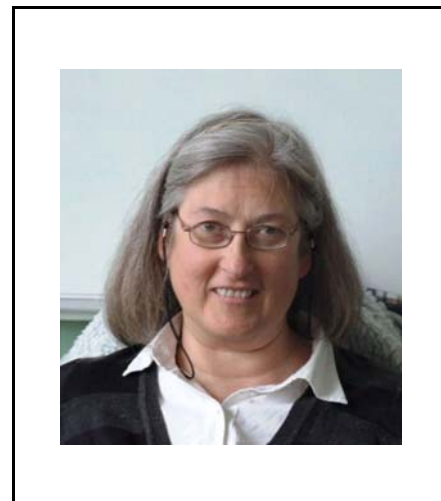

Personal Statement
